- 1. Organizing Authority:** The James Island Yacht Club and the United States Sunfish Class Association (USSCA).
- 2. Venue:** Lower Charleston Harbor adjacent to James Island Yacht Club.
- 3. Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 4. Eligibility:** Open to all members of USSCA or ISCA and one-design Sunfish class boats as defined by the ISCA. Class membership application is available at registration.
- 5. Advertising:** Restricted to Category A.

9. Fees: Regatta fee is \$40.00 before Aug 6, 2008 and \$50.00 after that date. Includes Sat/Sun lunches, Sun breakfast, and embroidered regatta hat. US Sailing Members receive a \$5 discount.

10. Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (See Part 1-4 "Decision to Race" of the RRS). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for any damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in.

13. Scoring: Low-point scoring system of the RRS. One race shall constitute a regatta. A competitor's worst race will be discarded if six (6) or more races completed.

14. Trophies: Top five (5) overall, top junior, top master, and top opposite male/female. Additional prizes awarded at discretion of organizing authority. Overall winner qualifies for 2009 World Championship.

16. Notes: The club lounge will be open throughout the regatta. Our liquor license will not permit brown bagging. Camping is permitted on grounds (primitive only). There are no RV facilities (power/water/etc). Pets are not allowed on club property.
